The course will last one full day spread over two days starting Saturday afternoon 1 p.m. with lectures, and will cover our clinical product PROSE “Prostate Spectroscopy and Imaging Exam”. The course will adjourn Sunday at about 1 p.m. It will consist of both medical and technical lecture presentations, hands-on acquisitions of prostate images and spectra from patients, clinical readings of a broad range of prostate examinations, clinical readings of the data acquired during the course, and hands-on utilization of the PROSE Functool Display Tool to analyze clinical prostate data. The participants will have access to workstations equipped with FuncTool, as well as to a 1.5T Excite system.

The participants are responsible for their travel and lodging expenses. There will be a registration fee of 1700 EUR (VAT included @16%) covering all costs related to the training including coffee breaks and a dinner on September 13th.
